AT&T Inc (T) lost eight cents to \$39.94 yesterday after the wireless carrier said first-quarter finances came in weaker because customers held onto phones longer and rival carriers offered new promotions on unlimited data plans. The company lost 191,000 postpaid subscribers, who had paid bills monthly in the U.S., on a net basis.

To diversify operations, AT&T is buying Time Warner Inc by end of 2017, to control cable channels like HBO and CNN as well as filming studio Warner Bros. AT&T shares dropped 0.6% to \$40.15 in five days.

Verizon Communications Inc (VZ) on Thursday reported its first-ever quarterly loss of subscribers. The industry's next-biggest leaders Sprint Corp (S) and T-Mobile US Inc (TMUS) are up 4.2% to \$8.94 and 4% to \$67.64, respectively in past five days to Wednesday 11:35 a.m.

In the quarter, AT&T's revenue dropped 2.9% from last year to \$39.4 billion. Net income fell to \$3.47 billion or 56 cents a share from \$3.80 billion or 74 cents a share a year earlier. In fourth quarter of 2016 the company earned \$2.44 billion or 39 cents a share.
