Stocks to Watch

Halliburton Co (HAL) added 25 cents to \$47.00 after the energy company said first-quarter revenue edged up 1.4% from a year ago to \$4.28 billion. Quarterly loss narrowed to \$32 million or four cents a share compared to negative \$2.41 billion or \$2.81 a share in 2016 when the company took substantial charges and added more rigs to stabilize.

IBM Corp (IBM) eased 38 cents to \$160.37 after the tech conglomerate is teaming with Swiss engineering company ABB Ltd (ABB) to ramp up presence in digital technology and Internet-of-things. ABB shares soared 1.3% to \$24.24.

T-Mobile US Inc (TMUS) closed up 2.2% at \$67.35 after the telecom carrier said first-quarter revenue rose 1.2% from last year to \$9.61 billion. Net income jumped to \$698 million or 80 cents a share from \$479 million or 56 cents a share a year ago.

The company added 914,000 subscribers who pay bills monthly, on a net basis, in the quarter ended March 31. This is down from 1.04 billion in the year-ago period.
